# Stopping Vandalism and Littering with Security



### **Problem**

Multiple incidents of littering, trespassing and vandalism were occurring at the historical Pompton Plains Railroad Station. Unwelcomed visitors would break lamp posts and windows as well as leave garbage behind. Having no preventative measures in place, the museum searched for a permanent effective solution. Working with and referred to by the local electrician, we were able to step in and provide service.

### Solution

XFComputers designed a system with our partners' solutions to prevent further vandalism. We upgraded their NVR (Network Video Recorder) with Wisenet WAVE from Hanwha to allow 24/7 camera monitoring. Installation of Outdoor SIP speakers from CyberData, powered by our VoIP partner 3CX, allowed the staff to make announcements and play messages remotely.

## Result

Since installation, no incidents have been reported by the Township. Upgrading the NVR made remote 24/7 monitoring and recording of the cameras possible. Along with the SIP speakers installation, the added security acts as a strong deterrent from trespassing, vandalism, and littering.
