



## **RTFM Button**



# Wall Mounting Options







	When the device is operational and linked to a network, you can use the Reset Test Function Management (RTFM) button (SW1 [see picture]) to announce the device's IP address or restore the device to the factory default settings.
ton (SW1)	To announce the device's current IP address:
	<ul> <li>Press and release the RTFM button within a five second window.</li> </ul>
	<b>Note</b> The device will use DHCP to obtain the new IP address (DHCP-assigned address or default to IPv4 Link Local if a DHCP server is not present).
	To restore the device to factory default settings:
	<ul> <li>Press and hold the RTFM button for longer than five seconds until you hear the device announce that it is restoring the factory default settings.</li> </ul>
